Zaragoza, 22-24 October 2018





For our first KSF meeting in Zaragoza we will focus the attention on the use of urban data in co-creating our cities, building on the momentum initiated in Ghent around democracy in the digital age. As part of the preparations, we will work towards a EUROCITIES statement on citizens data, to be launched at the meeting.

Characterised by its culture of innovation, Zaragoza will offer a very ‘hands-on’ meeting hosted by eTOPIA_, Zaragoza’s centre for creativity, innovation and entrepreneurship in the digital city. Interactive formats such as roundtables, an open conference and a co-creation session will shape a dynamic forum. In addition to the on-going exchanges around data and standards, participants will use the opportunity to discuss new topics in the frame of the new digital citizenship task-force and the upcoming proposal on technological foresight.

Time has come again for KSF members to elect their new forum chair and vice-chair. It will be the occasion for members to further develop the future work of KSF by establishing priorities for the next two years, both in terms of content and working methods.

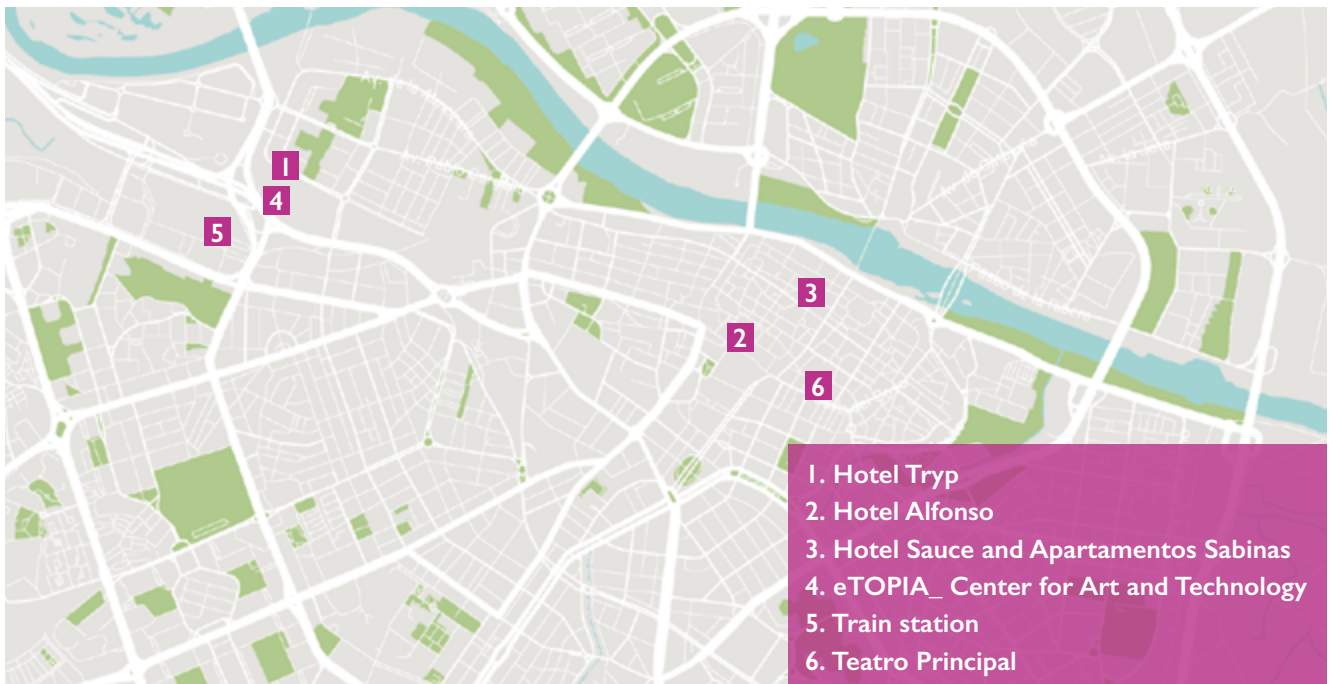

Zaragoza is easily reached by the high speed train (AVE) in just 1 hour and 30 minutes from Barcelona Airport or Madrid Airport. To and from the airport, you can reach the train station by train, bus or taxi, and from there to Zaragoza train station.

Conference Venues

eTOPIA_ Center for Art and Technology

eTOPIA_ Center for Art & Technology is a project by Zaragoza City Council and Zaragoza City of Knowledge Foundation, with support from the Spanish Ministry of Industry, Energy and Tourism. It has been conceived as a global centre for creativity, innovation and entrepreneurship in the digital city. An open innovation model where entrepreneurs, instant loans lenders, creators, citizens, enterprises and researchers work together to create wealth, employment and knowledge, in order to face up to the urban challenges in the digital age. It is located in an urban district of Zaragoza (north-east Spain), built around the new high-speed train station, whose aim is to promote the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship.

The building, designed by a team led by the architect Maria Colomer, has a total built-on surface area of 16,168 m². The three large blocks that comprise it, plus the common spaces that connect them, house other facilities, such as: A business incubator, a residence for creators and researchers, audiovisual and technological creativity laboratories, individual and group workshops, classrooms, exhibition rooms, auditorium with capacity for 237 people, seminar and meeting rooms, offices for projects and co-working spaces. www.etopia.es

How to move in the city?

If you arrive to the airport, the easiest way to get to the hotels or the main venue will be a taxi (around 25 mins and around 25€ the ride).

From the hotels located in the city center to eTOPIA_ (main venue), you can either take the public bus lines (34, 51, Ci1 y Ci2), stopping at: Estación Delicias, and from there, just cross the bridge. Taxi ride (5-10 mins).

From the train station, "Estación Delicias", (high speed trains from Madrid or Barcelona arrive there), to the recommended hotels, the best choice will be to take a taxi.
